## **2012 STATE RULES RELATING TO WESTERN CUP SERIES**

1. Western Cup class champions will be allocated black plates (to be supplied by Karting WA) with yellow numbers bearing their own State number. The plates are to be used only in the class they were awarded (1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE ONLY) and only within Western Australia.
2. For a CLASS to be eligible for final series points the CLASS must have a minimum of five (5) entries to constitute a class.
3. All points scored will count towards the final point tally for each driver.
4. Any competitor who competes at Midwest Kart Club will be awarded 200 bonus points for each class entered. It is not compulsory to do all rounds.

7. Engines and restrictors will be sealed.

8. **FORMAT:** 289 point system – all points count

4 heats - Ballot

Reverse Ballot

Highest to front

Highest to front

Winner of the day is the highest point scorer for that class

9. Individual clubs will co-join classes (as per Karting Manual) to run on the track simultaneously and/or adjust laps at their discretion.

10. Closing date for entries: 3 days from event. Late entries will be accepted up to last post on the Friday prior to the event on subscribed classes only. **No entries will be accepted on the day of competition.**

11. **ENTRY FEE** (*all fees inclusive of GST (where applicable) and National and State Track Development Levies*)

Senior - \$55.00

Junior/Rookie/Cadet - \$40.00

*(For all classes, if person is racing more than one class, second or subsequent entry fee will be \$20.00.)*

12. Karting WA to maintain points score for Western Cup Series.

## Special Conditions:

- Presentations will be ½ hour after posting of points
- Random engine measuring will be undertaken
- Please note on entry form if sharing a kart in different classes
- Enclosed shoes in the pit and grid area
- No Smoking – No Alcohol permitted in the pit area at any time

- Head sealing nuts must be fitted to engines as per rule 19.33. When engine seals are issued a competitor is to fit them – you must leave the tail at full length
- Drivers are not permitted on the track to practice until they have completed registration and scrutineering on race day
- Camping Ok
- NO DOGS
- No Scooters/Bikes/ Skateboards etc
